Description The course intends to provide a basic training for seafarers responsible for designated safety duties associated with the care, use or in emergency response to the LNG and other low flashpoint fuels on board ships subject to the IGF Code.

 - Take precautions to prevent hazards on a ship subject to the IGF code
 - Apply occupational health and safety precautions and measures
 - Respond to emergencies
 - Take precautions to prevent pollution of the environment from the release of fuels found on ships subject to the IGF code

Entry Standards The course is principally intended for candidates who require certification for basic training. Seafarers responsible for ships are obliged to undertake training designated safety duties associated with the care, use, or in emergency response to the fuel on board ships subject to the IGF Code. These seafarers have already completed an approved course covering occupational health and safety precautions and measures including carrying out firefighting operations on all types of tankers.
