

Course Title **Ship Handling / Bridge Team Management**

Code S003

Language English

Description The course is practical and theoretical and consists of exercises performed on a ship handling simulator. Classroom lectures, to provide the necessary theoretical background for the exercises, are included. The exercises increase in complexity as the course progresses and as trainees become familiar with the manoeuvring characteristics of the ship model and its response to the engine and helm in various conditions. Depending on the number and kind of participants various ship's types can be used and the course can be tailored to individual requirements.

Objectives The following subjects will be covered:

- To understand the effects of wind, current, shallow water, banks and narrow channels
- To carry out anchor manoeuvres under the influence of current and wind
- To carry out a river/canal passage
- To carry out berthing/un-berthing manoeuvres with and without use of tugs
- To establish a proper working bridge team
