

Course Title	Ship Handling for Yachts (in acc. to IMO Model Course 1.22)

Language	English
Description	The course is practical and theoretical and consists of exercises performed in the ship handling simulator. Classroom lectures, to provide the necessary theoretical background for the exercises, are included. The exercises increase in complexity as the course progresses and as trainees become familiar with the manoeuvring characteristics of a Container Vessel up to 400m in length and its response to engine and helm in various conditions.
